As you'll see, the Radical Bay 8000 is built using ATL Composite's pre-cut, pre-glassed Balsa DuFlex panels. With simple aluminium beams and this construction method, we expect she will be very quick and simple to build. Her slim hulls will make her a very quick sailer and the simple twin un-stayed rigs could not be easier to use. As an entry level design, she's sure to be a winner!
